

Sedgwick County Zoo is a large zoo, located in Wichita, Kansas. We are home to 3,000 individual animals of nearly 400 species. We have over 200 employees on staff.

We are a three doctor/two and a half technician, full service veterinary hospital with current equipment and facilities. We provide internship, preceptorship and externship training at our zoo with plenty of hands on experiences. Students will work with technicians to perform daily tasks as well as appropriate handling of emergencies, surgeries and dangerous situations.

Students must be currently enrolled or a very recent graduate of an accredited Veterinary Technology program. A 4-6 week commitment of 30-40 hours per week is preferred though duration of stay may be flexible with prior approval. It is recommended that the student have previous animal care/ veterinary assistant experience. A negative TB test (or negative chest radiograph) within 12 months is required and current rabies and tetanus vaccinations are highly recommended. There is no housing on site, but we can provide information on housing leads. No stipend is available. Students must be over 18.
